

## **Discussion Guide**

## Year 10 - Alcohol and Other Drugs

### **Activity Overview**

#### Understanding Costs: Legal vs. Personal Perspectives on Substance Use

- This lesson explores legal and personal costs associated with substance use.
- Students start with a drug categorization activity, followed by defining terms and creating a Venn diagram.
- The focus then shifts to collaborative group activities ranking community costs of alcohol.

### **Learning Intentions**

- Students gain an understanding of the cost of drugs and alcohol on society.
- Students are introduced to the nuances of different legal implications of drugs.

#### **Success Criteria**

- Students can identify some legal drugs and some illegal drugs.
- Students can explain the different ways people interact with drugs.
- Students can outline the legal and personal implications of drugs on individuals and society.

### **Teacher Notes**

# Warm-up: Brainstorm 10 minutes

- Group to brainstorm as many legal and illegal drugs as they can
- Tme limit: 3 minutes
- Refer to slide 2 in PowerPoint in 3 mins into the table in the PowerPoint slides 2.



# Legal Cost VS Personal Cost 30 minutes

- Students define adverbs listed in in the PowerPoint (Slide 3).
- This can be done by dictionary look-up, brainstorming on the board, or group discussion.
- Students create a Venn diagram with the two headings: Legal cost and Personal cost
- Students to fill each circle with the possibilities of legal and personal cost.
- Group discussion: Are there any results that fall into the middle section of both?

#### **Group Growth Cost List**

#### 30 minutes

- Individually students come up with 5 costs of alcohol and other drugs to the community.
- Students pair up and combine each student's list and create a Top 5 list
- 2 x pairs group together, creating group of 4, combine each pair's list and create a Top 8 list
- Move into groups of 6 and create a Top 10 list
- Now there will be 2-4 groups in total, write every cost on the board, discuss and debate what the top
   10 for the class would be

# Recap: Summarise in pairs 10 minutes

Back in their pairs, students to discuss and list all the things society currently does to control alcohol and other drugs in the community.
